Your invitation to me is based on Access to Justice petition to the National Judicial Council asking it to investigate allegations contained in the 14th July 2008 edition of TheNews magazine, where the magazine published details of what it claimed were call logs of communication between the Hon. Justice Thomas Naron, and Hon. Justice Ekanem of the First Osun State Gubernatorial Election Tribunal and a counsel representing one of the parties before the Tribunal, ex Governor Olagunsoye Oyinlola, Otunba Kalejaiye. The story was published at pages 20-31 of the Magazine.

When we saw and read the publication, we felt it was our duty to bring this to the attention of the National Judicial Council, to alert the Council of the allegations and ensure that they were investigated to determine the veracity of the serious assertions made. This is what we did by petitioning for an investigation of the allegations to the National Judicial Council.

At this time, I regret I am still unable to attend the Committee's sitting in person. However, I am making a copy of TheNews magazine which published the story available to this Committee. This magazine is the only source of our information and the only material upon which our petition is based. I believe that since this is a fact-finding Committee, the Committee is in a position to receive this document from me through this form of communication and can dispense with my personal attendance. I respectfully apply to the Committee to receive this magazine this way. However, if for any reason the Committee would like to have me testify in person before it, I would be grateful if it communicates this to me, and affords me an opportunity to appear before it.
